Establishment of Mitsubishi UFJ Asset Management (UK) Ltd. (DIFC Branch)

Also in May 2016, the Trust Bank established a representative office to build strong investor network in the region.

In line with its corporate mission, today, we established a branch office in the Dubai International Financial Centre (DIFC) with the aim of creating further business opportunities in the Middle East and providing high-quality products and services that meet the needs of customers in the region. Going forward, we will keep on improving the quality of services and meeting our investors' expectation.

The office will be operated as a MUAM (UK) branch under the regulatory and supervision of the Dubai Financial Services Authority. The representative office of the Trust Bank is scheduled to be closed soon after the launch of the branch.
